 - 7** Platform top: skeletal wacke- to grainstone, crinoidal-beds and boundstones

 - 5** Microbial boundstone-dominated upper slope
 - 4** Lower slope to upper slope transition
 - 3** Clastic lower slope: intraformational calcareous breccias
