Abstract (max. 300 words, Times New Roman 11)

The abstract must be prepared in English, on A4 paper size, with top and bottom margins of 2 cm and left and right margins of 2.5 cm, maintaining a multiple line spacing of 1.08. This template provides a clear structure for completing the abstract.

The title of the contribution should appear in Times New Roman 14, in bold, aligned to the left, and must not exceed two lines. Authors should be listed in Times New Roman 12, aligned to the left, using superscripts to indicate institutional affiliations; the corresponding author must be identified with an asterisk and their email address included. Affiliations should be provided in Times New Roman 10, in italics, each in a separate paragraph, indicating the full details of the institution.

The abstract text must be written in Times New Roman 11, justified, with a first-line special indentation of 0.25 cm and a maximum length of 300 words. Figures, tables, and equations should not be included, and all abbreviations must be defined at first mention. In-text citations should follow the author-year format: for a single author, (Lorem 2020); for two authors, (Lorem & Lorem, 2021); and for three or more authors (Lorem et al., 2022). When the author's name is mentioned within the sentence, the year should appear in parentheses immediately after the name: e.g., "as noted by Lorem (2020)." A maximum of three references may be included, formatted in Times New Roman 10, listed alphabetically and following an adapted style.

After the abstract, up to five keywords should be provided, separated by semicolons and ordered by relevance.
